Verification Process Checklist for 2025-2026

Please use this guide to help facilitate the completion of the verification process for your aid application:

- 1. Be sure to read the instructions for each section on this Worksheet carefully and thoroughly.
- 2. Write your name (the student) and Hampshire College ID number on top of pages 2 & 3 of this Worksheet.
- 3. If employers and amounts of earnings are reported in the Non-tax filing statement in Section C of this worksheet, we need copies of the 2023 W-2 forms from each listed employer.
- 4. If you checked Box 3A, 3B, 3C, or 3D in Section C, then you must complete Section D.
- 5. We need a "Verification of Non-filing Letter," or other similar document from a foreign tax authority if you are an independent student and did not file a 2023 income tax return with that foreign tax authority, OR if you are a dependent student and your parent(s) did not file a 2023 income tax return with that tax authority. We do not need this document if a 2023 tax return was filed or if you are a dependent student who did not file a 2023 income tax return (with IRS or foreign tax authority). See Section E of the Worksheet for more information.
- 6. If the IRS was unable to transfer tax data into your FAFSA you may either send us a copy of the 2023 IRS Tax Return Transcript for the appropriate tax filer: student, spouse, or parent(s) OR you may send us a SIGNED copy of the actual 2023 IRS 1040 tax return; send us Pages 1 & 2, and Schedules 1, 3, C, and F, if applicable. Please sign using a pen on the Sign Here line on Page 2.
- 7. If you, your spouse, or your parent(s) filed a tax return with a tax authority other than the U.S. IRS, you will need to send us a SIGNED copy of the 2023 tax return that was filed with that tax authority.
- 8. If you are sending any documents to the financial aid office be sure that the student's name is written on each form so we may match it to your file. Please do not send documents to us via email.

- 10. Review the common omissions listed below to help avoid any delays in the verification process.
- 11. Feel free to call the financial aid office at 413.559.5484 to speak with someone about the process.

Avoid these common omissions which may delay the processing of your Worksheet

- If you are a dependent student be sure to include your parent(s) in Section B.
- Your parent(s)' names MUST match the names reported on your FAFSA.
- If you (the student) were not employed in 2023, did not have any earnings from work in 2023, and was not required to file a 2023 IRS income tax return, be sure to check the box to statement 3A in Section C and complete Section D.
- If both of your parents were not employed in 2023, did not have any earnings from work in 2023, and were not required to file a 2023 IRS income tax return, be sure to check the box to statement 3C in Section C and complete Section D.
- If you (the student) or your parents were employed in 2023 and had earnings from work but were not required to file a 2023 IRS tax return, be sure to check the box to statement 3D in Section C, complete the Non-tax filing statement below Box 3D, complete Section D, and send us copies of W-2 forms.
- Be sure that Section F has your signature (the student) and a parent's signature, if required. Please sign the form using a pen. Include your parent's email address in case we have any questions.
